New Cross Branch Closing 30th Jan 2015

We have written to members who have recently visited our New Cross branch, and now need to let all our members know that this branch will be closing in January 2015.

Friday 30th January 2015 will be the last day the branch will be open to provide services for members.

The decision to close the New Cross branch was prompted by the new landlord's proposal to substantially increase the rent. After carefully considering a number of options, the Board has concluded that closure is the right decision.

We will continue to provide a full service at The Green Man, Bromley Road, Catford SE6, at our main office at Kirkdale, Sydenham SE26 and in St. Paul's Cray BR5.

Access Services Anywhere

Increasingly, more of our services can be used without visiting a branch. These include:

- **Pre-Paid Debit Card**, which can be loaded and used to access cash without visiting a branch.
- Credit Union Current Account, which provides cash machine, standing order, direct debit and bill payment services.
- **Upgraded web site services**, including loan applications and recent transactions online.
- **Telephone banking service** to listen to your balance and authorise transfers 24x7.

• SMS balances by texting the word "Balance" to 07537 410334

You can use these to access credit union services from your home or other locations whenever you wish.

Deptford Outreach Service

An outreach service is available for all members in the New Cross and Deptford area. This is provided with support from Lewisham Homes. We have a Service Level Agreement with Lewisham Homes until March 2015 and are confident that this service will continue. **Note:** *This service does not handle any cash.*

The outreach service is at Pepys Housing Office, 1a Eddystone Tower, Deptford, SE8 3QU, is open from Mon to Wed, 10am to 3pm.

Homelessness prevented

A woman fleeing domestic violence was referred to our Bromley Plus branch for a Homeless Prevention Loan. Once the loan was allocated, our staff helped her to open a Credit Union Current Account and to pay benefits in. She had only had a Post Office card account before this. We were able to set up direct debits for utility bills and a regular standing order to begin her savings.

"This has really made a difference to my life, I am finally in control of my money, I know that all my bills are being paid and my loan. But what makes me really happy I've finally learned to save and I haven't got to worry where I'm going to find the money when things come up that I can't plan for."

"The staff at Bromley+ are so helpful and friendly but most of all they make me feel comfortable and not embarrassed about my situation."

We are proud to work with both Lewisham and Bromley Councils to prevent homelessness. Since 2011 we have issued nearly 100 loans to help people find or keep a home.

People Matter Most

S. has a disabled son who is due to have major surgery soon. She has little income and had been unable to obtain credit elsewhere. Our Green Man branch arranged a small loan, which enabled her to take her son away, where he met his aunt for the first time. *"This has made such a difference to my family. We needed a break to enable us to cope with my son's illness and future treatment."*

Johan Allen, our outreach officer in Deptford, helped two Lewisham Homes tenants to open CU Current Accounts and to transfer a whopping £5,000 from their rent accounts.

One had £3,600 on her rent account reduced to £600, and the other had $\pounds 2,000$ credit on his rent.

The first tenant was so happy with the service she gave Johan a box of chocolates. *Well done Johan!*

Faster Loans – Update

Since the launch of our faster loan decision service, in January 2014, we have seen a sustained rise in borrowing through the credit union. By responding more quickly we hope to divert funds from expensive "payday loans" – playing our part in "competing Wonga out of existence", as Archbishop Justin Welby put it.

4 in 10 loan decisions are now made "next day", in addition to fast-track SAYB loan top-ups and Flexi-loans. For example, in June 2014:

- 496 loans were granted, total of £274,000 – average £552 each.
- 354 were SAYB loans, of which approx 230 were fast-tracked.
- 98 loans were accepted next day
- 156 loans were accepted after further assessment.

9 in 10 decisions are within a week. Most delays are waiting for further info – please be prompt if we ask!
